Toscana Siepi 2017

Black cherry, plum and tobacco flavors mark this rich, fleshy red, which is fruity up front, turning firmer and drier on the finish, where cherry, almond and tobacco notes echo. Fine overall balance and length, with a beam of fruit at the very end. Sangiovese and Merlot. Drink now through 2024. 2,458 cases made, 250 cases imported. (Oct 15, 2020)

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Toscana Philip 2016

Cherry, black currant, wild herb and woody flavors converge with the elegant structure in this red, which is harmonious and supple, with a fresh finish that echoes the fruit, savory and spice notes.

Cabernet Sauvignon. Drink now through 2025. 3,300 cases made, 1,500 cases imported. (Oct 31, 2020)

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Toscana Philip 2015

Bold, assertive tannins uplift the plum, black cherry, earth, leather and spice flavors in this muscular red, which is balanced in a youthful way, with concentration and a long, fruit-driven aftertaste. Best from 2022 through 2033. 3,750 cases made, 2,000 cases imported. (Oct 15, 2020)

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MAZZEI

Maremma Toscana Belguardo
Tirrenico 2016

This red is elegant, with an intensity to the flavors of black currant, blackberry and pencil shavings. Though young and well-structured, this shows harmony and should age for the short term. Cabernet Sauvignon, Alicante, Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot. Drink now through 2024. 4,417 cases made, 500 cases imported. (Oct 15, 2020)

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
